Teresa to check with local artist and Kelly may have a back-up if it doesn't work out.

Dog Park Benches

Civic Club bought one very sturdy bench. It should be delivered by next week at the latest. The fence in the park also needs to be replaced. The city is getting bids to do this now.

Folly Fine Art Installation

At the previous meeting Deana shared her idea about a public art installation and provided info she received from Hilton Head. She also discussed her idea of starting a foundation on Folly that would contribute to funding the installation program. This project will take a lot of help and coordination. Parks & Rec will be the medium to manage the project with the help and coordination of other local organizations. Laurie said she would talk to a few people about funding for the foundation. Could consider reaching out to the fine arts programs at local

colleges to start a competition or something similar. This is in the conceptual stages now.

Walk/Bike maps

Content info for the maps have been sent to Little Dog Agency. The agency has told us they can get a map for us but Parks & Rec would need to get a company to print out the maps. Would like to blow it up and eventually put at the river park. Little Dog Agency also showed possible pop up maps that could be made. The agency is getting more information on the pop up maps and will hopefully have more information for our next meeting.
