2. **Chairman's Comments**
Explained the purpose of the meeting.
3. **Approval of Agenda**
Riggs made a motion to approve and Burroughs seconded the motion. The agenda was approved without objection.
4. **Approval of Previous Minutes**
Riggs made a motion to approve and Burroughs seconded the motion. The minutes were approved without objection.
5. **New Business:**

Request for Funds:

a. Charleston County Parks & Recreation Commission: \$1,500

Presentation was given by Michael Bradley from the Charleston County Parks & Recreation Commission. The CCRPC is requesting funds to offset the cost of hosting the South Atlantic Lifesaving Championship on Folly Beach, July 13-14, 2016. This event is a competition bringing competitors and spectators from along the East Coast to promote skills, safety and public health in the aquatic environment and to showcase the high level of lifeguard readiness, skills, and abilities of the ocean lifeguards competing.

To determine the appropriateness of the event, the foundation members asked questions as to how it will benefit the citizens of Folly. Questions such as what will the money be

spent on, how and where the event will be advertised, will vendor booths and food be offered, and will restaurants be participating as sponsors.

Motion was made by Riggs and seconded by Burroughs approving the appropriateness of the event. All were in favor.

Riggs made motion to amend the amount of \$1500 to \$700 which was seconded by Burroughs and all were in favor.

Riggs made motion to award a \$700 donation contingent on advertising in the Sandspur and Folly Current. Motion was seconded by Burroughs with all in favor.

b. Folly Beach Parks & Recreation Board: \$500

Presentation was given by Angel Ward, Chairman of the Parks and Recreation Board. The FBPR will be hosting a family fun night event named Folly Family Fun Night at Folly River Park, Tuesday evenings from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. This event is geared towards families with children ages 2-12. Most events are free and offer something for everyone. The funds will be used for marketing, supplies, and vendor costs.

The foundation inquired about the Civic Club's involvement, details of specific vendors, what the cost would be to the public, will there be food, and what local businesses/vendors involvement is.

Motion was made by Riggs and seconded by Burroughs approving the appropriateness of the event. All were in favor.

Riggs made motion to award FBPR the requested amount of \$500 for the upcoming Folly Family Fun Night event. The motion was seconded by Burroughs and carried unanimously.
