1. Call to Order/Roll Call
Present: Travers, Houghton, Keller, Ezelle, Foxhall, Grooms, Lesesne
Staff Present: Jolley, Lutz
2. Approval of Minutes: RM 2.25.20, WS 5.19.20
Motion to approve February 25th and May 19th meeting minutes was made by Ms. Foxhall, seconded by Mr. Grooms and carried unanimous.
3. FY21 Final Budget
The FBPR FY21 draft budget was presented for review and approval (attached). Changes: Folly Family Fun Night line item was moved to the Community Coordinator budget and remaining Shadow Race Park funds of \$2262 was put in FBPR Reserve. Motion to approve final FY21 budget of \$7650 for council approval was made by Ms. Houghton, seconded by Ms. Lesesne, and carried unanimous.
4. Parks and Facilities Reopening-Update
Folly River Park may be open to the public by the end of August 2020. The Community Center will be open to the public in coordination with the CCPL schedule which is unknown at this time due to COVID.
5. FFFN 2020-Update
Ms. Jolley reported all is on track for this event.
6. Recreation 2020-Update
Ms. Jolley reported tennis, soccer, and pickleball programs are going well. Group tennis and basketball clinics will begin soon. Ms. Houghton suggested hosting Croquet at Folly River Park.
7. Pirates Cove Signage-Update
Court rules signage is complete and ready for install. Should be up by the end of the month. The main park signs (Tim Goodwin) should be ready for install by then, too. Staff is pleased with the signage. It is likely to be duplicated at other parks.

8. Board Comments
Ms. Keller reported a tree down and railing damage this morning at Shorebird Park. Mr. Lutz will repair as soon as possible. Ms. Keller also reported loss/damage to jasmine vines at Folly Bark Park. Seems loss is a result of yard maintenance. Ms. Keller proposed a solution of adding pavement or gravel (like Hudson side) to lessen yard maintenance and damage to existing vines. Board members will do a site visit to vote on a solution at the next meeting.
9. Staff Comments:
Ms. Jolley asked P&R Board Members to stay in touch with FBPR website and Facebook page to help promote services/events.
Due to the tentative election runoff, the July meeting date or location needs to move. Motion to schedule next meeting date for July 16th at 6:30 pm via Zoom was made by Ms. Houghton, seconded by Ms. Foxhall, and carried unanimous.
