3. Budget-Update
FY21 & Reserve-Jolley updated the Board with current balances and budget policy through October 1, 2020.
4. Parks and Facilities
Folly Bark Park-Ms. Keller reported wood chips were dumped in front of cell tower and requests the wood chips no longer be dumped there. Requesting to move unused picnic tables from Folly River Park to Folly Bark Park. Discussed placement of gravel on Erie side.
Folly Beach Community Center-Being utilized by Folly Beach staff and City Council due to City Hall renovation. Facility is closed until further notice.
Folly River Park-Pier repair is coming along well. Park is closed through November.
Pirate Cove Playground-Tennis court netting needs repair.
Shadow Race Park-No trespassing sign needs to be turned around. Ms. Oltmann reported a suicide note found at the park and is proposing "Words of Encouragement" signage or something similar be installed.
Shorebird Park-Sign needs replacing due to fading.
Wave Watch Park-Reported that the swing set is wobbly, graffiti on bathroom door needs painted over, and brush in left corner needs cleaned up.
5. PARD Grant-Update
Pirates Cove project is complete except for landscaping which will be finished this week.

6. Recreation 2020-Update
Ms. Jolley will be requesting recreation programming **approval** (fall/winter) at October 13th City Council meeting if/when emergency ordinance expires. Basketball, Pickleball, Soccer, Tennis, and Yoga services are being offered.
7. Tideline Tours-Sponsorship of After School Programs
Motion was made by Ms. Foxhall and seconded by Ms. Lesesne to approve subsidizing \$10 per 5 session package to residents who wish to participate in this afterschool program. Motion carried unanimous.
