

Folly Beach Municipal Court Judge

The City of Folly Beach is accepting applications for the position of part-time Chief Municipal Court Judge. Folly Beach Municipal Court is held every Friday morning and the Chief Judge sets the schedule for the judges with input from the Associate Judge, generally each presides over court two times per month. The Chief Judge is also responsible for signing warrants and returns from the Folly Beach Public Safety Department as well as administrative scheduling and other matters outside of Court.

The City seeks applications from attorneys licensed to practice law in South Carolina whose other work does not involve representation of clients in Folly Beach criminal cases. The position is appointed by City Council pursuant to City Code 32.07 and SC Code 14-25-1. The annual salary is \$10,600 per year and the position participates in the South Carolina Retirement System administered by SCPEBA. The term will be a two-year term ending March 2023.
